Please note the following Club Guidance Notes

- **After school clubs apart from Tennis, Fencing and Cricket:** Please do not send in the money for clubs until spaces have been allocated or you receive a letter or confirmation of a place.
- **Allocating Places:** Places are limited for most clubs and teachers will allocate places as fairly as possible. If a club is full, children should in most cases be able to participate later in the year.
- **Commitment:** To ensure fairness for all children it is expected children will attend clubs when they have been allocated a place and must excuse themselves with the club leader if they cannot attend.
- **Club Cancellation:** Where staff absence or professional commitments force a club to be cancelled, either school or the club leader will attempt to contact parents. Where parents cannot be contacted or when time does not make this possible, children will stay in school until the time the club was due to finish.
- **Clothing:** All children involved in Sports clubs will be expected to wear PE clothing and follow PE guidelines. Club leaders will let children know if there are any other clothing requirements. All football club children preferably should wear shin pads and we recommend wearing them. However, as children are not wearing studded boots, shin pads are not essential.
- **Parental Transport:** Where parents are kind enough to volunteer to assist with transport e.g. to sports matches, please ensure that a Transport Form has been completed and that you fulfil all the requirements as given. In addition, please check that your Insurance company knows you will be transporting children for the school. This should not incur any extra costs but will ensure that you are covered for this additional service. You can complete a form from the Office. Please note booster seats are now statutory for children under 135cm.
- **Expectations:** Whether run by a member of staff or not, school rules apply at all times. Children will be asked not to attend if they fail to fulfil these expectations.
- To help us provide the very best additional and extra-curricular experiences for our children, there is a **small surcharge** on after school clubs, included in the costs above. The money school collects will go partly towards providing the resources needed to run some clubs and towards some additional experiences, as well as developing our school grounds and facilities. The way you pay for clubs will remain the same. However, we do not wish children to miss out on these enrichment activities, so if cost is prohibitive, please do speak to the School Office. Thank you for your understanding.
