

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>In English this term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Write an opening to a story about a fire that has started. ✓ Use WOW words to engage a reader (adjectives, noun phrases and expanded noun phrases) ✓ Write a letter to the Fire fighters and share what we have learnt. ✓ Write a story set during the time of the fire. ✓ Write a diary as if we were Samuel Pepys. ✓ Recognise and read phonemes and graphemes in our daily phonic lessons and developing our punctuation and spelling skills. <p>Texts we will read: Toby and the Great Fire of London, The diary of Samuel Pepys, Vlad and the great fire of London.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>In Mathematics this term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Understand that multiplication is repeated addition. ✓ Understand that division is repeated subtraction. ✓ Know that multiplication can be done in any order BUT division cannot. ✓ Use repeated addition and arrays to solve multiplication sums, as well as more formal methods. ✓ Use sharing and repeated subtraction to solve division sums. ✓ Rapidly recall 2, 5, and 10 times tables and their corresponding division facts. ✓ Choose and use appropriate units of measure for length (cm, mm, m), capacity (ml, l) and mass (g, kg) ✓ To create and interpret block graphs, pictograms and tally charts. 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>In Science this term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults ✓ Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) ✓ Reflect on the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Creativity</u></p> <p>Our topic for this term is 'Why was the great fire of London so great?' and we will be learning about 'The Great Fire of London'. As part of our 'history' learning, we will be exploring how the great fire started and talking about 'Modern London' today. We will be creating timelines and thinking about how long ago this event happened. As part of history, we will be learning about primary and secondary evidence, as well as eye witness accounts and how we find out about the past. We will be reading some extracts from Samuel Pepys diary and why his accounts were so valuable.</p> <p>In art we will be creating scenes based on the great fire of London. We will be using chalk and techniques such as marbling to recreate the London skyline during the great fire.</p> <p>As part of this topic we will also be paid a visit by our local fire fighters on Monday 19th November, and be learning about fire safety through our OWL adventures day on Thursday 29th November.</p> <p>Finally, I am sure we will all have a fun filled and busy term and I look forward to helping your child be 'the best they can be.'
