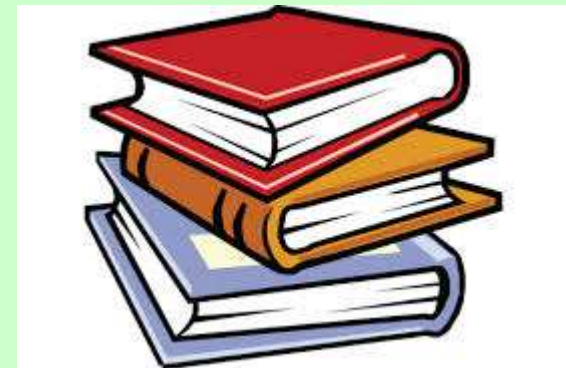

Home learning

- **Weekly** home learning tasks given out and collected in the following week. The children will all be given a **home learning folder** – please ensure they use these.
- It will usually contain:
 - **Spellings**
 - A weekly **Maths** and **English** task
- At school - spelling test weekly
- There is also an expectation that children will read **every day** at home and to parents regularly and learn times tables – using Times Tables Rock Stars.

Projects

Usually related to the topic and will cover different subjects. It is much more open-ended and designed to allow the children choice and challenge in their learning at home.

There will usually be **one project per term** and the children will have around **4 weeks to complete them.**
