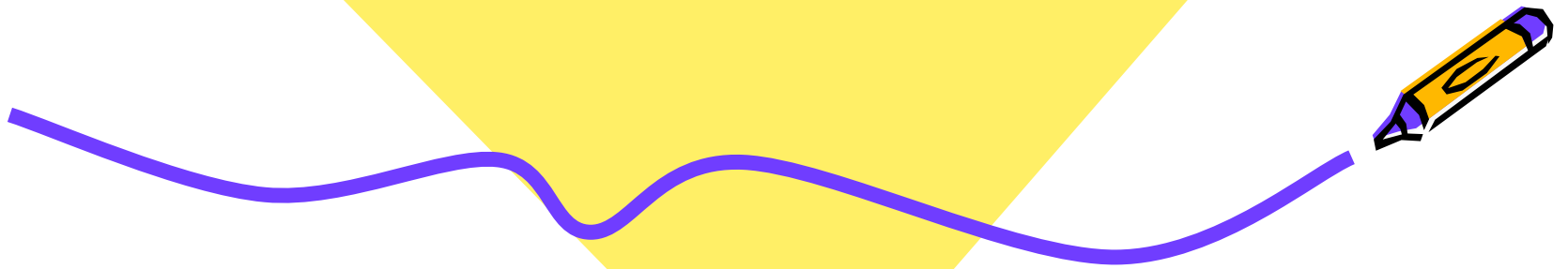


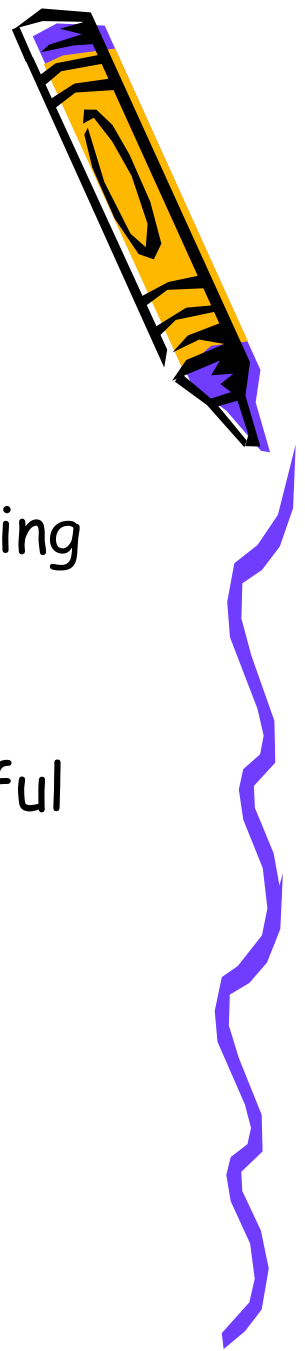

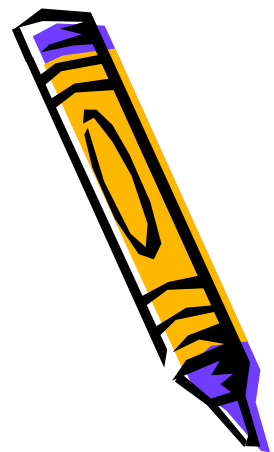
# The Reception Class Curriculum

- Role of the environment in planned and purposeful play



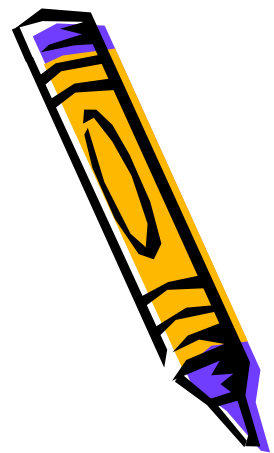
# Areas of learning

- Specific Areas - Literacy, Maths, Understanding the World, Expressive Arts and Design



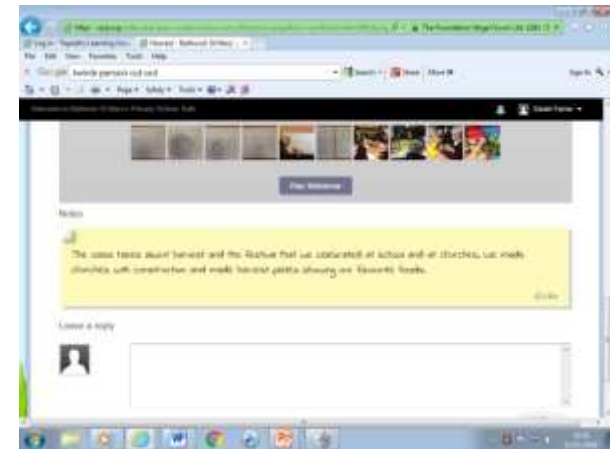
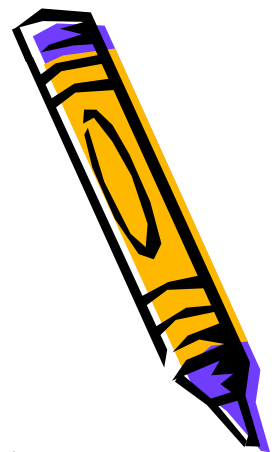
# Assessment and Records

- Transition into Year 1



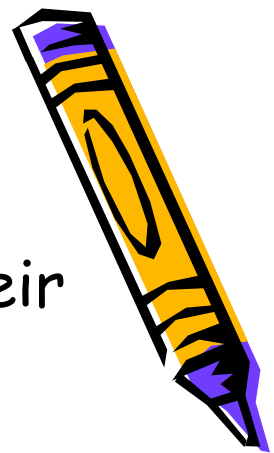
# Learning Journals

- Permission slip in paperwork to be returned



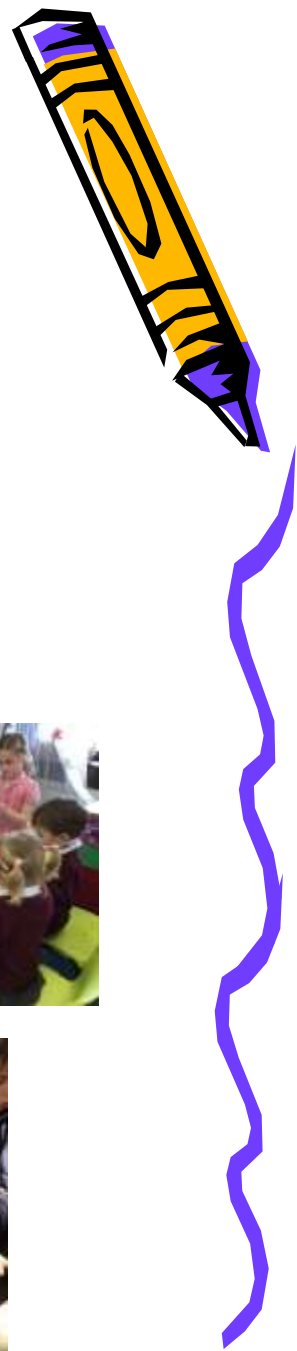
# Typical day in Reception...
