

<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p><u>Writing</u> –descriptive writing of a winter scene (use of class text), focus on writing variety of sentence types and lengths, write non-chronological reports and persuasive texts (linked to Mexico and Mayans); write biographies, instructions and explanations (linked to DT and science). Suspense story writing linked to Mexico and use of texts to include: The Nowhere Emporium, journey to the river sea, the explorer.</p> <p><u>Reading</u> – begin to use past papers to tackle longer, more detailed, comprehension questions. Continue work with measurement and learn how to convert and use measures to solve problems.</p> <p>Begin to use past papers and questions when appropriate.</p> <p>Mental maths strategies and tests carried out weekly.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p><u>Living things and their habitats –</u> Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common characteristics, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. Research the work of Carl Linnaeus.</p> <p>Investigate micro-organisms around the home and understand how to stay healthy. Explore uses of bacteria and viruses.</p>
