**Our themes for this term are:

and

Our PE day is still Wednesday. Please remember to practice daily with your child's phonics book and reading book, as well as re-reading books for fluency. Book changing days continue to be Monday and Thursday.

Personal, social and emotional development:

We will continue to work with different groups and partners in our class. We will be challenging ourselves to try new activities. We will be thinking about how much we have learnt in Reception. Nearer to the end of summer we will think about moving to Year 1 and transition.



Communication and Language:

We will be learning stories about farms, food and growing. We will continue to practice listening in different situations and recalling information that we have heard. We will be exploring new vocabulary and enjoying conversations with friends!

Physical Development:

We will be practicing our letter formation this term to make sure each letter is correctly formed with exit flicks. We will be learning about keeping our bodies healthy and will be going on a trips to learn about where our food comes from. We will be using equipment in PE and practising for Sports Day!



Literacy:

We will be sharing stories and information books about food and farming. We will be continuing to practice our phonics focusing on writing captions and sentences independently. We will continue to practice our reading skills!



Maths:

This term we will making sure that we can recognise and order numbers to 20. We will be using language involved in addition and subtraction. We will be doing lots of problem solving involving numbers— halving, doubling and pairs to name a few!



Understanding of the world:

We will beginning to use the ICT suite for using simple software. We hope to go on a trip to visit a farm and learn about the animals. We will be growing plants and watching the changes over time. We will visit Sydney gardens and our OWL area to look for signs of summer!



Expressive arts and design:

We will be turning our role play area into a farm shop to begin with practicing our shared narratives with others. We will be designing, planning and making models. We will be using instruments to play along with farm songs. We will be making life cycle pictures.
