### Science

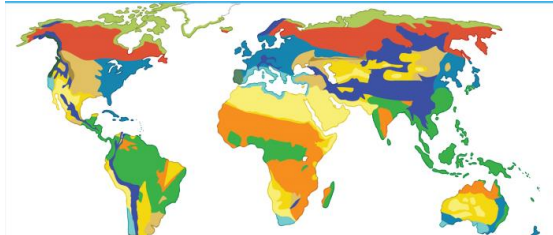
#### Forces
