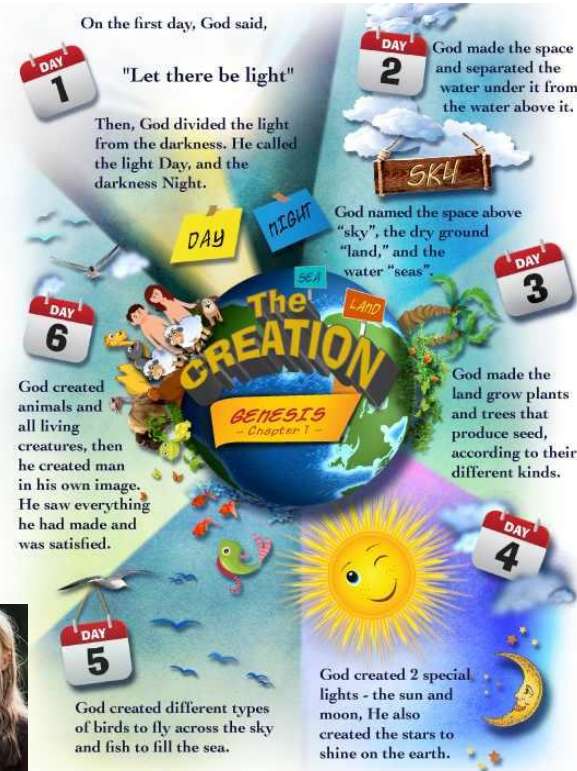
Topic: Why was the Great Fire of London so great?

KNOWLEDGE BUILDING BLOCKS

PUPILS WILL KNOW THAT CHRISTIANS BELIEVE:

- God created the universe.
- The Earth and everything in it are important to God.
- God has a unique relationship with human beings.
- Humans should care for the world because it belongs to God.



Key Vocabulary

- **Christian** - a person who believes in God and Jesus. Follows Christianity.
- **Create**- To make something.
- **Environment**- all the things together that surround animals and humans in the natural world, including the air, the water, and the soil
- **Nature**- the physical world and living things in their natural state; all things that are not made by people.
- **World**- the universe; everything that exists.
- **Restful**- peaceful and quiet
- **Destruction**- the act of ruining completely or destroying.
- **Conservation**- the protection of natural resources, such as soil, water, or forests, from loss, pollution, or waste.
- **Charity**- a group or organisation that helps people in need.
- **Ecology**- the scientific study of the relationships between living things and their environments.
- **Church** - a place used for Christian Worship. The Christian family/community.
