Key Vocabulary:

Modroc - plaster bandage that can be used to make sculpture

Wrapping - cover by winding or folding

Smooth – not rough; even

Plaster – cover or smear with or as if with a paste used for coating.

Pinch - squeezing between the thumb and fingers

Pressing - apply pressure to (something) to flatten

Rolling - move or cause to move by turning over and over on a surface

Rubbing - move along the surface of something with pressure

Stamping - to move with force and speed downward upon something.

Coil - to wind into rings or a spiral
