M KNOWLEDGE BUILDING BLOCKS

PUPILS WILL KNOW THAT:

- Easter is very important in the 'big story' of the Bible. Jesus showed that he was willing to forgive all people, even for putting him on the cross.
- Christians believe Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans.
- Christians believe Jesus rose again, giving people hope of a new life.

OUTCOMES 2

BY THE END OF THIS UNIT, PUPILS ARE EXPECTED TO BE ABLE TO:

- Recognise that God, Incarnation, Gospel and Salvation are part of the 'big story' of the Bible.
- Tell stories of Holy Week and Easter and make a link with the idea of Salvation (Jesus rescuing people).
- Give at least three examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus as saviour in church worship.
- Think, talk and ask questions about whether the text has something to say to them (for example, about whether forgiveness is important), exploring different ideas.









The story of Easter





Texts to share that reflect on feelings of hurt, blame, apologies, reconciliation, and forgiveness.



Easter - a Christian festival to celebrate the resuurection of Christ.

Jesus - the son of God Resurrection - Jesus rising from the dead.

Cross - the symbol of Christianity. The symbol that represents Jesus dying on the cross.

Creation - When something is made. Christians believe God created/made the World.

Salvation - rescuing people. How Jesus recued Christians.

Forgiveness - the act of forgiving someone.

Reconciliation - to rebuild a friendship/come together. **Sin** - doing something that God believes is wrong.

Empathy - to undestand and share the feelings of someone else.

Sacrifice - to give something up that is important to you. To kill someone.

Good Friday - the day that Jesus died on the cross.

Maundy Thursday - the time before Good Friday when Jesus shared his last supper with his disciples.

Disciple - a person who folowed Jesus and believed in him. A good friend.
