### What should I already know?

\*To make some comments about things from the past. E.g. features, events, people and themes.

### Skills I will develop:

- \*To be able to point out some similarities and differences between aspects of my life and the life of people in the period I am learning about.
- \*To use a wider range of “time” terms including: recently, before, after, now, later.
- \*To use past and present when describing events
- \*To make some comments about why people did things, why events happened and what happened as a result of these.
- \*To find answers to some simple questions about the past from simple sources of information.

### Homes



- \*Families had to store food without a fridge.
- \*The living room usually had the best most expensive furniture in.
- \*Families ate and played games at the dining table.
- \* They lit fires in rooms to keep warm.
- \*No electric kettles so water was heated on a stove.

### Toys



- \*It was hard to get hold of toys and they were expensive. Sometimes children made their own.
- \* Toys were simpler but, in many ways, still similar to the toys we have today.

### Schools

- \* Boys and girls were split- boys did woodwork and metalwork and the girls had needlework lessons
- \* Separate playgrounds for boys and girls
- \* Younger teachers joined the Armed Forces

- \* Many of the buildings and bridges we are familiar with in Bath still exist today
- \* Bath has grown and there are now more people living here.

### Key Vocabulary ( including definition)

**Bath:** The city where our school is. It is the largest city in Somerset.

**Building:** A large structure built for people to live in or do things in. Houses, schools, stores, and offices are buildings

**School:** The place where children go to learn

**1943:** The year it was eighty years ago

**2023:** The year it is now

**Home:** the place where a person or animal lives.

**Timeline:** show the order in which events happened.

**Chronological order:** Arranged in the order of time.

**Compare:** to look for things that are the same and things that are different.

**Similarity:** Something that is the same

**Difference:** Something that is not the same

**Past:** Gone by in time and not longer existing

**Present:** Happening now
