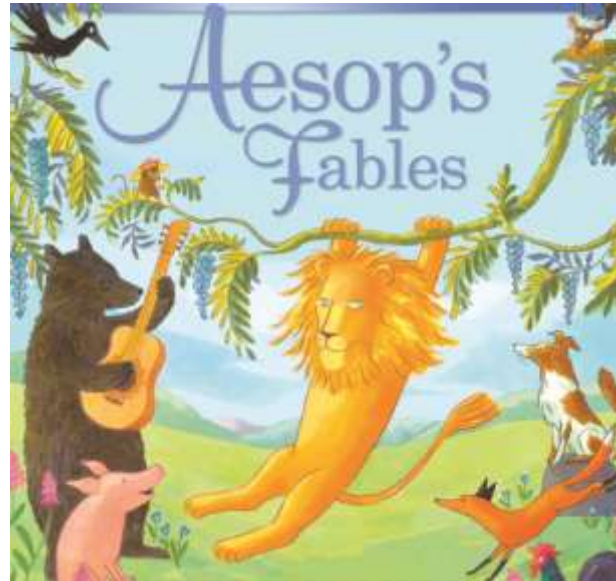
Grammar content:

Reading:
