Key Vocabulary (including definition)

Map	A specially drawn picture of a place from above.
Picture map	A picture map is not drawn to scale and is not as accurate as a map.
Globe	A spherical model of Earth showing oceans and continents.
Sea	A sea is a large area of salt water that is a part of an ocean and partially enclosed by land.
Ocean	An ocean is a huge body of salt water which covers nearly 71% of Earth's surface.
Direction	Where something or someone is pointing or moving.
Fieldwork	To get out and about to get a practical understanding of your surroundings.
Geographical features	The natural and manmade resources that can be found on the Earth's surface.
