- Humans should care for the world because it belongs to God.

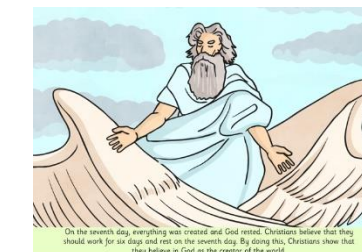
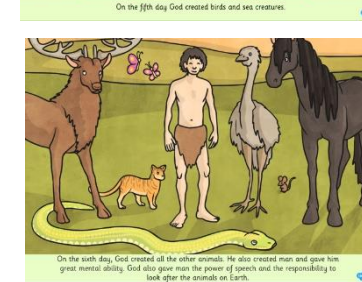
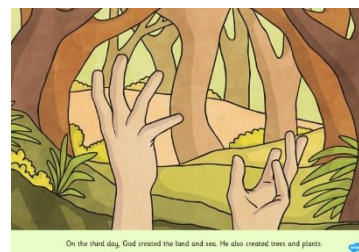
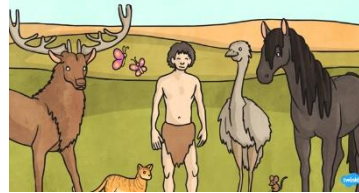
### ★ OUTCOMES

- 5. Think, talk and ask questions about living in an amazing world.



### CHRISTIAN CREATION STORY



**Key Vocabulary ( including definition)**

**Creation-** bringing something to life. Christians believe God created the World.

**Creator-** someone who had made something.

**Harvest-** a time to gather in crops. A time Christians are thankful for the food they have.

**Thankful-** appreciating something or someone.

**Christian-** a person who believes in God and Jesus. Follows Christianity.

**Charity:** kindly giving/helping other people who are in need or have less than you. (Explain to the children that you can be charitabel with not only money but with time,resources,thoughts and words)
