## Nouns

A noun is the name of a person, a place, an animal or a thing.

Examples: Billy, Birmingham, June, dog, cat, doll, England.

## Verbs

A verb is a doing or action word. (This includes 'to be' or 'to have').

Examples: bounce, drive, work, cook, splash, laugh.

## Adjectives

An adjective is a word that describes a noun (the name of a thing or a place).

Examples: colourful, beautiful, smart, orange, tall.

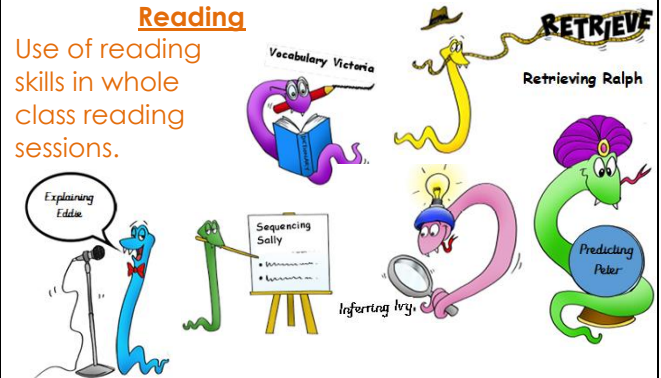
## Adverbs

An adverb is a word that describes a verb or adjective.

Examples: very, fast, slowly, loudly, quietly, soon.
