## Grouping animals

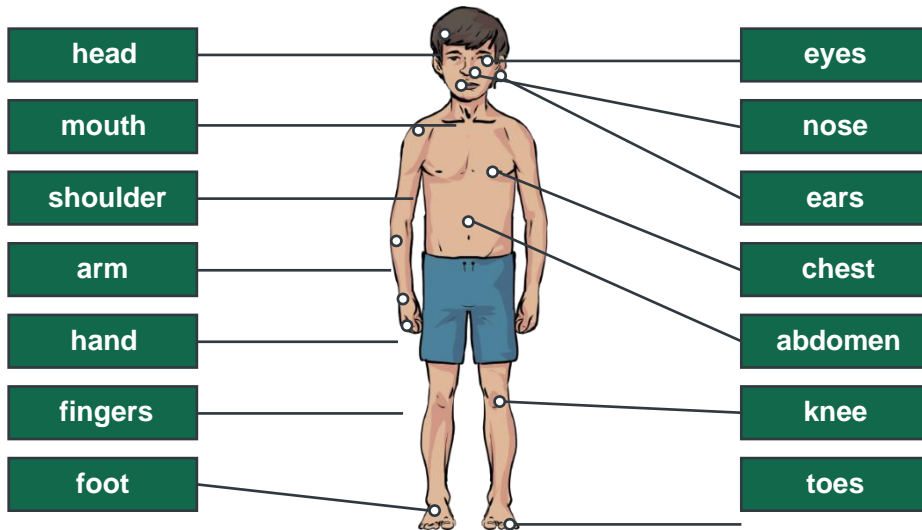
<p><b>Fish</b> Fish live in <b>water</b> and have <b>gills, scales</b> and <b>fins</b> on their body.</p> 	<p><b>Birds</b> Birds have <b>feathers, beaks and wings</b>. Most birds <b>can fly</b>.</p> 	<p><b>Mammals</b> Mammals have <b>fur or hair</b>. They drink <b>milk</b> from their mother when they are young.</p>

<p><b>Amphibians</b> Amphibians are born in <b>water</b> but then develop <b>lungs</b> and live on <b>land</b>.</p> 	<p><b>Reptiles</b> Reptiles are <b>cold-blooded</b> animals with scales that <b>live on land</b>.</p>

## Key Vocabulary

**amphibian** - an animal that is born in water but later develops lungs and lives on land

**animal** - a living thing

**bird** - an animal with feathers, a beak and wings that can usually fly

**carnivore** - an animal that just eats meat

**fish** - an animal that lives in the water that has scales, fins and gills

**herbivore** - an animal that just eats plants

**mammal** - an animal with fur or hair that feeds on milk from its mother when they are young

**omnivore** - an animal that eats both plants and meat

**reptile** - an animal with scales that is cold-blooded and lives on land

**senses** - something that helps us gather information about the world (sight, hearing, touch, smell and taste)
