Please note the following Club Guidance Notes

- If the cost of any club is prohibitive, please speak to Mr. Purkiss we do not wish any child to miss out from enrichment activities.
- There are a number of other free clubs run during the school day by school staff which are not charged for, including Choir and Ensemble.
- Children staying for second session clubs are welcome to book into Wraparound Care to save going home and back to school.
- If it is extremely wet, children will be in a classroom for a theory lesson. In the event of club leader illness, where possible all children will be offered a free space in Wraparound Care for the duration of the club.
- Club Cancellation: Where staff absence, professional commitments or very poor weather force a club to be cancelled, either school or the club leader will attempt to contact parents. Where parents cannot be contacted or when time does not make this possible, children will stay in school until the time the club was due to finish.

• Clothing:

- o Children should wear what they have worn to school that day and bring a change of footwear (trainers/daps)
- \circ Club leaders will let children know if there are any other clothing requirements.
- o Children should have a named water bottle
- Expectations: School rules and behaviour expectations apply at all times. Children will be asked not to attend if they do not fulfil these expectations.
- To help us provide the very best additional and extra-curricular experiences for our children, there is a **small surcharge** on after school clubs, included in the costs above. The money school collects will go partly towards providing the resources needed to run some clubs and towards some additional experiences, as well as developing our school grounds and facilities. The way you pay for clubs will remain the same. We do not wish children to miss out on these enrichment activities so if cost is prohibitive, please speak to Mr. Purkiss. • When paying on Parent Pay:

- These are available on ParentPay.
- o From then, please login to Parent Pay and click on 'Pay other items'.
- o Please note, Parent Pay will show a balance to pay for ALL clubs relevant to your child's year group.
- o Click on the club you wish to book and pay for the term.
- o Your payment acts as a guarantee of a space in the club. Clubs will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.
- o We have therefore given advance notice to all parents and carers to ensure a fair system
