## Key Vocabulary

**horizontal line** – a line that runs right and left across the page

**vertical line** – a line that runs up and down across the page

**angle** – an angle is formed when two lines meet

**spiral** – a curve that starts at a fixed point and continues to go around and around

**curve** – a smooth or rounded line

**zig zag** – a line with lots of short sharp turns or angles

**pattern** – something that happens in a repeated way

**Kandinsky** – an artist that created abstract paintings

**cross-hatching** – drawing lines to show light and shadow

**watercolour** - a type of paint that can be mixed with water to create layers of color on paper

**abstract** – A style of art that does not try to look realistic.
