Key Vocabulary (including definition)

Baren	A round, smooth pad used to press paper against an inked wood or linoleum block.
Block	A piece of thick, flat material, with a design on its surface, used to print repeated impressions of that design.
Burin	A tool used by an engraver with a steel shaft and a sharp point at one end and a handle at the other.
Gouge	In relief printing, a tool for cutting and clearing areas from a block of wood or linoleum.
Brayer	A small roller used to spread printing ink evenly on a surface before printing.
Overprinting	Colours are printed over the top of one another.
