Equally, some residents of Darlington Road are understandably getting increasingly frustrated when those dropping off or picking up children from school simply park in front of driveways completely blocking access. This not only causes more congestion, but blocking pavements forces some families - especially those with buggies or wheelchairs - onto the road.

At Bathwick St. Mary, we always seek to be the best neighbours we can. A reminder to ALL those driving to school to be courteous to other road and pavement users. DO NOT block driveways and DO follow the Highway Code - for our children's safety and community's benefit. Thank you.

The importance of school attendance

In every newsletter and in regular communication we remind our community that no holidays are authorised in term time. Children make progress in their learning when they know more, remember more and are able to do more. Our carefully sequenced curriculum is built around this pedagogy — and this is one of the key reasons why school attendance matters so much. Congratulations to Years R, 2, 3 and 6 who had 100% attendance (which includes authorised absence) for the month of December.

A reminder – bottle tops and corks!

Celebrations over the holiday? If you have any clean beer bottle tops and champagne and prosecco corks for school as you can please – we use them in OWL Adventures. Thank you!

Important safety notice

We have children in school who have **life-threatening allergies.** We take all our children's safety extremely seriously and as such **the following foods and foods containing these ingredients are banned from the school site** (this includes bringing snacks after school for your children or during clubs time):

- Sesame seeds and food containing sesame (sesame can be found on or in a variety of food, including on rolls, bread, oil, hummus)
- Nuts and food containing nuts
 - X All 'Tree nuts' this includes cashew, hazelnuts, almonds, walnuts, pistachio, macadamia, pecan and Brazil nuts
 - X Peanuts and chestnuts
 - X Pine nuts and Pesto

Some food packing uses wording such as, 'This product has been produced in a factory that handles nuts and/or sesame' or 'May contain nuts and/or sesame'. We only ban foods that state nuts or sesame in the ingredient list.

Severe weather

In the event of very severe weather, it may be necessary to close or partially close the school. We will always do our very best to remain open, but with many staff living outside of Bath, due consideration is given to safe travel. B&NES Council website no longer keeps a list of school closures, therefore if we need to close the school we will email and text all parents and carers.

And finally...

Please have a look at the key dates coming up in the term ahead. As ever, please do stop me in the playground or make contact to share ideas, concerns or questions. Bathwick is a great school, but there are always things we can do to improve and develop — and I am always willing to hear your ideas and comments.
